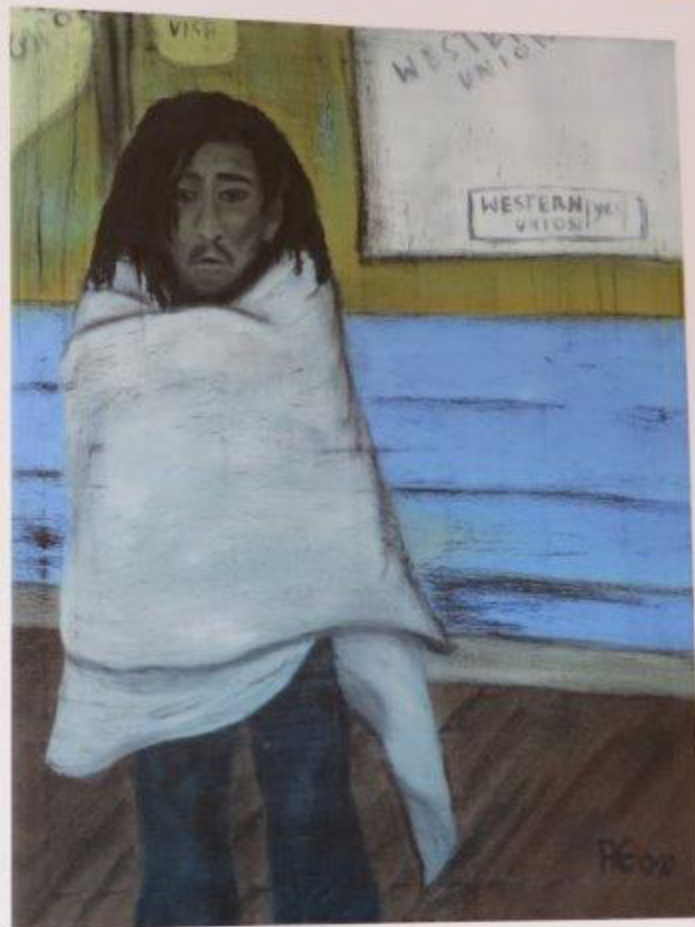


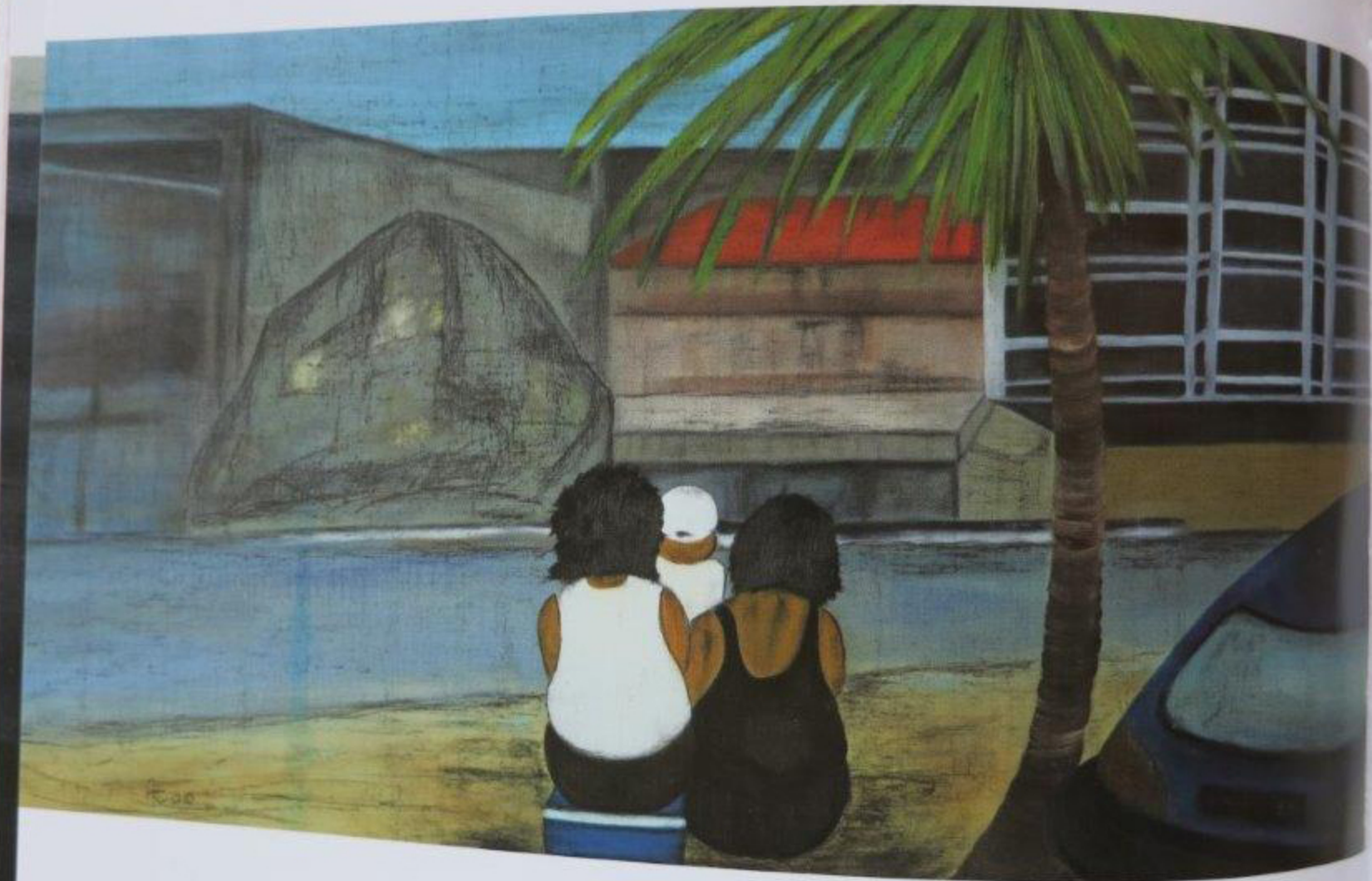

Andreas Eiserbeck was born in 1967 in Hildesheim. Ten years later he moved to Munich, where he began to train as a fresco painter when he was 21 years old. He spent the year 1990 studying in Berlin. Between 1997 and 2000 he devoted himself to private studies and had a studio space for more live drawings and also worked with Stefan Hryak. In the end of 1999 Eiserbeck returned to Munich where all the pictures and drawings were shown. He was later to set up the studio in Hildesheim. In 2004 his first solo exhibition was published in 2005 by Kunstforum International in Paris and one year later he was given a 1 year stay in Karlsruhe. Further he became a member of the foundation Felix Kluge, Hildesheim. The art book 'Andreas Eiserbeck – Signs of Voyage' has been published in 2012 through Farnham Art Management. Since his return to his studio in Munich became his main he moved himself in the beginning of 2015, where he now has more than 100 students who study in Munich and are a priority in exhibition space.
